

“Superteam” 2009 Thanksgiving Camp

Thank you for your interest in what will be the 6th annual Superteam Thanksgiving Race Camp.

What it is: A concentrated 2½ day pre-season training camp to get USSA/WJR/MHSSC racers, of all ages and classes, comfortable with updated techniques, equipment, and “body changes” for the updated race season.

Where this is happening: Brule Ski Area in Iron River, MI. Roughly a 4 hour driver from Milwaukee, WI.

When: Friday, November 27th thru Sunday, November 29th.

Friday:

- Initial and GS specific drills w/ minimal gate (some hero or brush sets if time allows) and video work.

Saturday:

- GS gate training in the a.m., followed by additional GS or slalom drills in the afternoon. Video on-going.

Sunday:

- Slalom gate practice/drills, with video.

How much: You have choices this year, so the sooner you sign up the better! As always, lift tickets are **included** in the camp fees:

- September - \$250.00 (3 days)
- October - \$300.00 (3 days)
- November - \$350 (3 days, but need prior approval to check availability)

Single day training is available on any of the three days for \$125/day.

Who is involved: Area HS/WJR/USSA ski programs. The idea being that not everyone would have the time, or money, to travel out west; yet, would still like to get quality training and a good jump on the upcoming season.

Coaching: We have an extremely talented group of coaches this year. Each coach is USSA certified, and all have years of ski race/coaching experience in anything from CUSSA through MHSSC. If want more detailed information, feel free to contact us so we can talk with you on any concerns you might have.

What else:

- Low coach to athlete ratio is extremely important to us. And, as a result, the number of athletes allowed will be limited. It's strongly recommended that you get your information and payment in early to ensure a spot at this year's camp.
- Parents are also invited to ski at Brule; lift tickets will determined by Ski Brule. Racer's tickets will also be honored for skiing after training.
- Video will be used each day of the camp, with appropriate viewing opportunities. In addition, we will be a tentative tuning clinic on Saturday evening, from Les Moise.
- Lodging is not included in the package; however, Brule has everything from condos/chalets to rooms across from the lodge (www.skibrule.com; 906-265-4957); or, the Americinn in Iron River, MI

(www.americinn.com, 906-265-9100) is only 10 minutes away. It also has a pool/sauna/Jacuzzi/exercise room, and is within walking distance of some great places to eat.

- Snow; it is early season, so the natural precipitation has the potential to be minimal. Even so, Ski Brule has an amazing snow making system which allows them to blow snow early in the season. Total snow amounts on the hill can dictate the amount of time we can train, and is determined by management. We determine what's available every morning to get the most out of our training.

What about food: The Brule Café serves breakfast for the ski camps and will continue serving through dinner.

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT (“Agreement”)

For the “Annual” Ski Season-Policy Year starting Nov 27th, 2009

In consideration for myself OR my child participating in the snow ski related activities, **offered by** (alpine ski school / club / org) **Superteam Race Camp** (“activity”) **I represent that I OR my child understand** the nature of this Activity and **I am OR my child is qualified**, in good health, and in proper physical condition **to participate** in such Activity. I acknowledge on behalf of myself OR my child that **if I OR my child believe event/Activity conditions are unsafe** we will immediately discontinue in the Activity.

It is **fully understood that this activity involves risks** of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and/or death, **which may be caused by** my OR my child’s own actions or inactions, **those of others** participating in the Activity, **the conditions** in which the Activity takes place, or the **negligence** of the “releasees” named below, and that there may be other risks either not known to me OR my child, or not readily foreseeable at this time; and **I OR my child fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility** for losses, costs and damages I OR my child might incur as a result of my OR my child’s participation in the Activity.

I hereby release, discharge and covenant not to sue Superteam Race Camp, it’s respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers, and employees, any sponsors, advertisers, and, if applicable, owners and lessors of the premises on which the Activity takes place (each considered one of the “Releasees” herein), and release and discharge them from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the “releasees” or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations; and **I further agree** that if, despite this release, waiver of liability, and assumption of risk, that I, or anyone on my behalf OR on behalf of my child, makes a claim against any of the Releasees, **I will indemnify, save and hold harmless** each of the Releasees from any loss, liability, damage or cost which may incur as the result of such claim.

I have read this RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, and understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it, and have signed it freely and without any inducement or assurance of any nature, **and intend it to be** a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law, and agree that if any portion of this agreement/release agreement is held to be invalid the balance, notwithstanding, shall continue in full force and effect.
